## BECOMING STUDENT VOLUNTEER ALUMNI

All eight JGG Student Teachers graduated from Bakchinhchien Hun Sen High School and Romlech Hun Sen High School. They are now what JGG calls Student Volunteer Alumni (SVAs).

They are now attending universities in Phnom Penh. Now three new SVAs are staying for no charge at JGG's Phnom Penh dormitory, and the other four will be staying for no charge at JGG's dormitory in January 2023. One SVA decided to learn in Pursat. The courses they will choose at the universities are Information Technology, Law Business Management, Mathematics and Biology. The new SVAs began looking for full-time jobs so they can support themselves while attending university full-time. Already, one of the new SVAs

are now having good jobs in the micro finance sector. With their strong English and leadership abilities they learned from JGG, it will be no problem for all the new SVAs to find employment in Phnom Penh.

Before the new SVAs left for their universities, JGG's Director organized a meeting with them. At the meeting many topics were discussed including the JGG dormitories, JGG's loan program to help new SVAs financially survive the first year at the universities, and the importance of choosing a good major to study. The point was also made that the new



SVAs should look for jobs that allow them to keep using and learning English. English continues to be one of the most important job skills needed to get a good job in Cambodia

### **WEEKEND COMPUTER, GRAMMAR AND MAJOR SUBJECTS TRAININGS**

So that they pass the comprehensive 12th Grade Examination, JGG worked closely with the state school's professional teachers to manage these eight 12<sup>th</sup> grade student teachers to be trained on the key subjects of English, mathematics, chemistry, biology and physics.

The program also focuses on preparing these students for the comprehensive state school 12<sup>th</sup> grade examination and learning about various universities.

## UPDATE ON COVID-19 IN CAMBODIA

Good news for Cambodia as active COVID cases drops but otherwise it is important to note that the Ministry of Health have said that the daily COVID figures are not representative of the number of current COVID cases in Cambodia. The data are based only on those who come for test or are migrant workers returning from Thailand who are checked at the border. According to the Ministry of Health authorities, since the onset of the pandemic in early 2020, **as of December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022**, Cambodia has had a total of **138,591 confirmed cases** of COVID-19, **135,462 recoveries** and **3,056 deaths**.

The vaccination process in Cambodia continues to move forward. As of the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2022, a total of 15,242,368 individuals got vaccinated, 14,607,504 received two doses. 10,426,480 received a booster dose, with 4,770,742 receiving a 4<sup>th</sup> booster, and 1,232,633 receiving a 5<sup>th</sup> booster dose.
